

Asylum Justice is a small South Wales charity that offers free legal services to asylum seekers and refugees who have no access to legal aid. Asylum Justice is at the coalface when it comes to fighting for justice for some of the most vulnerable people in Wales: people who have fled war and persecution to seek safety for themselves and their families.

What We Do

Asylum Justice is run by a team of dedicated volunteers, with one full time Legal Director and one part-time Legal Advisor. The charity has an office in Cardiff Bay and runs an extremely busy weekly drop-in session in the City Centre at the City United Reformed Church. Over the past two years the charity has assisted over 400 clients. A particular area of need is making Family Reunion Applications as legal aid is no longer available to assist with this vital process.

Appeal for Funds

We are grateful to have received funding which covers our core costs for the office and one solicitor, but we urgently need funds for additional costs such as expert reports, postage and translation of essential documents — which can add up to £1,500 a month. Given the absence of any similar service in Wales, we would like to take on a second (part-time) solicitor so as to meet the increasing demand we face for our services.



A Client's Experience: Aziz, a refugee from Syria

When I got refugee status I immediately looked for someone to help me do a family reunion application so my wife and daughter could join me, but the solicitors wanted £800. I hadn't found a job yet and the application was too complicated for me to do on my own, so when a friend told me about Asylum Justice, I went to their drop-in session and met the legal director. She took my case details and then did the application. Now, finally, my wife and daughter were able to travel safely to the UK.

All the other clients I know have had this level of service – we are really struggling to reunite with our families we've had to leave behind in Syria, and Asylum Justice are the only people able to help us.
